The purpose of the race is to assist the Foundation's fundraising efforts for the Brougham Central Hotel Restoration Project. Each 'adopted' duck is eligible to race.

This Saturday, August 25 and September 15, Foundation members and friends will be at Pickering Town Centre with Rubber Duckie RACE tickets to sell. They also plan to set up at the museum village booth at Pickering Markets. Tickets are \$5 each or 3 for \$10 and currently available at Ajax Pickering Board of Trade, Pickering Town Centre (Info Centre), Pickering Chiropractic Health Centre (Liverpool Road), Royal Men's Hairstyling & Barber Shop (Oklahoma) and members of Pickering Museum Village Foundation.

"After September 16 tickets will only be available from Foundation members and at the Fall Family Festival to allow the adopted ducks to go into training. We don't want anyone crying fowl if their adoptee doesn't float well" says Pat Dunnill, Chair of PMVF. "We hope to have all the ducks adopted and turn the creek into a sea of yellow bobbing duckies as they race by the cheering crowd to the finish line."
