PineRidge Arts Council Terms of Eligibility

Artists' eligibility and responsibility

The Tenth Annual PineRidge Arts Council Juried Art Show is open to all individual members of PRAC and/or residents of Durham Region.

- Categories – Adult (19 years and up) and Youth (13 to 18 years)
- Due to limitations of space, a maximum of two pieces of work will be accepted from each artist, and explanations of the piece cannot be displayed.
- Insurance coverage for the work submitted is the responsibility of the artist, PineRidge Arts Council is not responsible for loss or damage.
- Artwork should not be entered unless the artist can arrange for it to be delivered and picked up on the required dates and times.

Eligibility of artwork

- Art previously exhibited at a PRAC Juried Art Show will not be accepted.
- Only original work (no copies of works by other visual artists, whether paintings, photographs, illustrations or classroom works which have been demonstrated on by instructors) may be submitted.
- Artwork must remain in the McLean Community Centre until Sunday, November 30, when the show is completed.

All works must be appropriately presented

- Maximum size, including any frame is 102 cm x 102 cm (40" x 40").
Maximum weight, including glass, frame etc. 9.1 kg (20 lbs.)
- Each must have rings or screw eyes (no sawhooks) on both sides at the back of the entry, placed not more than one third down from the top of the frame.
- The wire must be taut and of sufficient gauge to hold the work properly when hanging from chains.
- Wet art, faulty or poorly wired frames, those with only sawhooks, will not be accepted for entry.

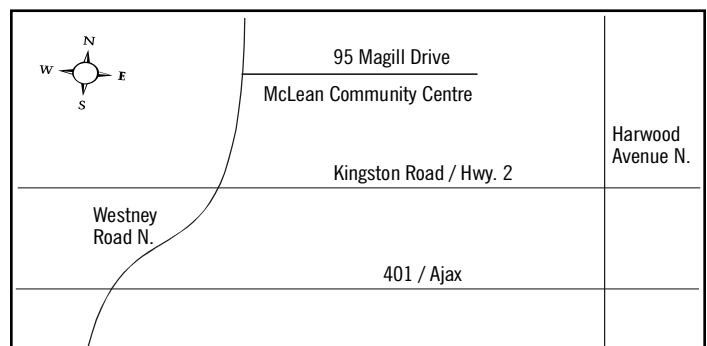
The PineRidge Arts Council reserves the right to photograph the artists and work for publicity, web posting and other not-for-profit purposes.

Kal Honey is an award-winning OCAD graduate, artist and graphic designer. In his fine art practice, Kal works in mixed media, exploring the potential of unorthodox methods and materials, combining them with a refined aesthetic and sophisticated use of colour and design. For the past 15 years, Kal has been a partner in Eye-to-Eye Design, a well-regarded boutique design studio specializing in editorial and promotional design for magazines. Kal routinely shows in some of the more competitive juried exhibitions in the GTA, including those at the Art Gallery of Mississauga, the Art Gallery of Peel and Oakville's Town Hall. He was recently one-half of a two-person show (with wife and partner Kim Lee Kho) at the Whitney Gallery in Brampton's Peel Heritage Complex, and is currently part of the Instructors' Show (from the Haliburton School of the Arts) at the Rails' End Gallery in Haliburton. Kal teaches classes for the Haliburton School, Koffler Centre for the Arts, numerous community art groups, and The Station Gallery in Whitby.

Kim Lee Kho grew up in a family of artists, surrounded by art and art history. An award-winning painter and graphic designer, her first loves are drawing and portraiture, while her latest work combines multiple media, (digital, traditional and photo-based), done on a large scale. Kim's exhibition schedule has been hectic, including shows at the Propeller Centre on Queen St West in Toronto, Le Centre d'artistes Voix Visuelle in Ottawa and as part of a group exhibition in Alberta that will be travelling for over a year, under the auspices of the Prairie Art Gallery in Grande Prairie, Alberta. Kim recently had her first solo show in the art gallery at the Toronto School of Art. Kim will be teaching this Fall at Visual Arts Mississauga, the Central Ontario Artists' Association and Koffler Centre for the Arts.
