## Pickup of Artwork at Close of Show

Artist to arrange for pickup of artwork on Sunday, November 27, from 1 to 4 P.M. There is no secure storage after the pickup dates and times.

## PineRidge Arts Council Terms of Eligibility

### All works must be appropriately presented

- **Maximum width**, including any frame is 102 cm (40")
- **Maximum weight**, including glass, frame etc. 9.1 kg (20 lbs.)
- Each must have rings or screw eyes (no sawhooks) on both sides at the back of the entry, placed not more than one third down from the top of the frame.
- The wire must be taut and of sufficient gauge to hold the work properly when hanging from chains.
- **Wet art, faulty or poorly wired frames, those with only sawhooks, will not be accepted for entry.**

### Artists' eligibility and responsibility

The Annual PineRidge Arts Council Juried Art Show is open to all members of PRAC and/or residents of Durham Region.

- Categories – Adult (19 years and up) and Youth (13 to 18 years)
- Due to limitations of space, a maximum of two pieces of work will be accepted from each artist – explanations of the piece cannot be displayed.
- Insurance coverage for the work submitted is the responsibility of the artist, PRAC or Town of Ajax are not responsible for loss or damage.
- Artwork should not be entered unless the artist can arrange for it to be delivered and picked up on the required dates and times.

### Eligibility of artwork

- Art previously exhibited at a PRAC Juried Art Show will not be accepted.
- Only original work (no copies of works by other visual artists, whether paintings, photographs, illustrations or classroom works which have been demonstrated on by instructors) may be submitted.
- Artwork must remain in the McLean Community Centre until Sunday, November 27, when the show is completed.

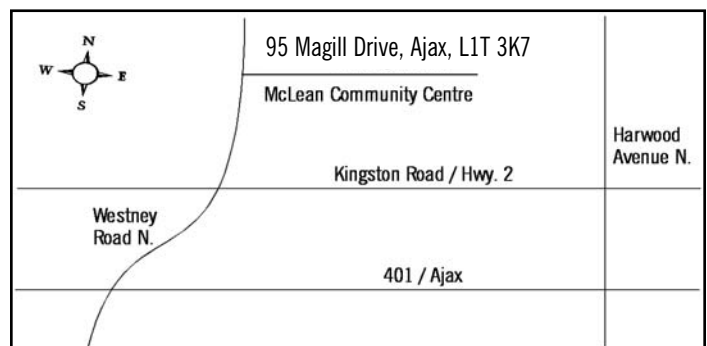

2011 Juror ~ Ernestine Tahedl was born in Austria and received a Master's Degree in graphic art from the Vienna Academy of Applied Arts. She immigrated to Edmonton Alberta in 1963. Participating in group and traveling shows, she also won acclaim with solo exhibitions in Austria, France, Japan, the USA and this country. Her awards include the Graduation Prize of the Austrian Government 1961 and the Allied Arts Medal of the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada 1966. In 1967 she received a Canada Council Arts Award. She was elected a member of the Royal Canadian Academy of Arts in 1977 and of the Ontario Society of Artists 1984.

She received the Governor General's Canada 125th Anniversary Medal in 1993, the recipient of the 2000 Arts and Letters Award from the Arts and Letters Club of Toronto, and the Queen's Golden Jubilee Medal in 2002. A retrospective of her work covering 60 years was organized by the Varley Art Gallery in Markham in 2006 and toured to several other galleries in Ontario. She is preparing for an exhibition of her work in Vienna for 2012. Her works are shown nationally and internationally and represented in Public and private collections in Canada and abroad. Her studio is in King City, Ontario.
